11. Bio-diversity, global warming and ecosystem
12. Eco-feminism

Suggestions for Abstract:

The abstract should not exceed 250 words. It can be either in English or in Bengali. It should include title of the abstract, the author's name, designation, institutional affiliation, mailing address, contact number, E-mail id. Authors are requested to kindly send the abstract through email latest by 10th August, 2018.

Note: Submission of abstract is necessary for pre-seminar publication of Abstract book.

Suggestions for full paper:

The length of full paper including tables, diagrams, illustrations, references, etc should be between to 4000 to 6000 words. The full paper should be either in English or in Bengali. For English, typed in MS-Word in Times New Roman with font size 12 and 1.5 spaced. Notes and references should be arranged as endnote in the Harvard style format. Full version of papers should be submitted in soft copy latest by 16th August 2018. A Committee will review the full papers and information regarding acceptance, modification shall be communicated to the authors subsequently.

The presented papers in the seminar will be published from a reputed publishing house with ISBN.
